

**First day (signposted in red) SS 1 – 4 Monte Corvos**

First driver: 10h23 – 15h18

Km 16,43

Road closing hour: from 7h23 to 18h45 on 16th May

**Zone A at 3,6 km from the start**

Access road:

1. from Olbia follow the road signs to Nuoro and go onto the State Road SS 131 dcn, which is a four-lane State Road,
2. after 14 km, at the km 131, take the exit signposted direction Padru,
3. go along for about 10 km, reach Padru and take the left to Buddusò,
4. after about 17 km, at junction Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go on to direction Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at junction Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn left onto State Road SS389 direction Alà dei Sardi,
6. pass through Alà dei Sardi and go on to direction Buddusò,
7. at the entrance to Buddusò leave the junction to Pattada on right and pass through the village following the road signs to Bitti,
8. when you leave the village, turn left onto the State Road SS389 direction Bitti,
9. after about 3 km, at the km 44 of the State Road SS389, go on to the wide rough road on the left and go along it for about 400mt.

Notes:

Easy access road and good parking possibility in the nearby fields.

Hair pin bend to left followed by an interesting fast stretch with opened bends on a wide and very good earthed roadway. Good visibility and safe spectator areas.

**Zone B at 10,83 km from the start**

Access road:

1. from Olbia follow the road signs to Nuoro and go onto the State road SS131 dcn, which is a four-lane State Road,
2. after 14 km, at the km 131, take the exit signposted direction Padru,
3. go along for about 10 km, reach Padru and take the left to Buddusò,
4. after about 17 km, at junction Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go on to direction Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at junction Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn left onto State Road SS389 direction Alà dei Sardi,
6. pass through Alà dei Sardi and go on to direction Buddusò,
7. at the entrance to Buddusò, leave the junction to Pattada on right and pass through the village following the road signs to Bitti,
8. when you leave the village, turn left onto the State Road SS389 direction Bitti,
9. after about 4 km turn left at the Nuraghe Loelle. When you reach the gravel road, having the Nuraghe on the left, go onto the wide gravel road on the right, in the opposite direction to the one used by the Special Stage 7-10 Punta Pianedda the next day.
10. go on in this way following carefully the road signs arranged by the organization along the full 4,2 km.

Notes:

Easy access road to a Public Area, sufficiently large with good parking possibility.

Hair bin bend to left with a sharp bend which, from a wide straight road goes onto a light slope, where the roadway is narrower. Good visibility in a safe way.

**Note!**

Most of the access gravel road, which you drive after having left the State road SS389, will be the course of the Special Stage 7-10 Punta Pianedda the next day. We suggest that you do not stay overnight nearby this State Road because you risk to being locked in this area.

In any case you do not leave your vehicles unattended nearby the course because you could cause the cancellation of the race.

Don't try to reach the start of the Special Stage because of the scarce width of the road, which is reserved only for the transit of the racing cars. The road will be closed to traffic from 8h23 to 18h18.

The same rule is valid for the end of the race, in which the access road will be closed to traffic from 8h50 to 19h30.

Please avoid parking vehicles which could hinder the regular transit of the racing cars because you could cause the cancellation of the Special Stage.
