

### First day (signposted in red) – SS 3 – 6 Terranova

First driver; 12h07 – 17h02

Km: 15,39

Road closing time: from 09h07 to 20h 30 on 16<sup>th</sup> May

#### Zone F at 5,39 km from the start

Access Road:

1. From Olbia follow the road signs to Nuoro and go onto the State Road SS131, which is a four-lane State Road,
2. after 14 km, level with the 131th km, take the exit to Padru,
3. go along for 10 km and after having reached Padru, turn left to Buddusò,
4. after about 17 km, at the crossroads Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go in direction Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at the crossroads Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn right on to the State Road SS389 direction Monti,
6. after about 4,8 km you will find on right a gate which goes onto the Special Stage and to the public area.

Notes:

Excellent access road and good parking opportunities along the handy gravel road which is on left, on the opposite side of the gate, which goes onto the Special Stage.

If you park your car along the State road SS389, please pay attention as not to hold up the normal traffic.

Good visibility of an interesting hair pin bend on the right coming from a straight road and going on to a slope, which goes on to a mixed road of about 2 km.

#### Zone G at 10,52 km from the start

Access road:

1. from olbia follow the state road SS199 direction Sassari up to the crossroads to Monti,
2. turn to Monti and go along the Provincial Road SP 147,
3. pass through Monti and at the exit, in Via Roma, turn left along the State Road SS 389 direction Alà dei Sardi and go on for about 11,5 km.

Notes:

Many parking opportunities along the handy State Road SS389.

Long straight road followed by the entrance to a forestry yard on right, with a challenging hair pin bend from asphalt to gravel through a gate.

Going along the Special Stage you will find some bends of different ranges, which alternate with short straight stretches.

Many opportunity of choice but often limited visibility because of a thick forest.

Another way to enjoy this SS, is walking in the opposite way of the special Stage, along an asphalted straight road of the State Road 389, you will reach a faster hair pin bend from asphalt to gravel. Also this hair pin bend passes through a gate. Before there is a mixed stretch with interesting bends.

Best visibility and wide public zones.

#### Zone H at km 15,12 from the start

Access road:

1. From Olbia follow the Provincial Road SP24 direction Loiri,
2. having reached Loiri, go on to Berchiddeddu turning right on to the Provincial Road SP, which is immediately in the centre of that village,
3. pass through Berchiddeddu and go on direction Mamusi,
4. go along for about 5,5 km and after having passed through some small village villages, turn right on to the Provincial Road SP79 direction Alà dei Sardi- Monti and go on for a few kms.
5. you must **only** park on the right in the special parking area, staged by the organization and you must go on foot along the Provincial Road SP 79 for about 900m, up to the end of the SS. At last you must go on foot along the further 500 m in the opposite way of the SS.

Notes:

Fairly good parking opportunities in the field.

There is a hump along a quite fast straight stretch, well visible thanks to a fire barrier area.

**Rally d'Italia Sardegna**

| dal 15 al 18 Maggio 2008 – Guida per gli spettatori/Spectators Guide

**You must park absolutely out of the carriageway** of the Provincial Road SP79 as not to hinder the transit of racing car to the service Park in Olbia, because you could cause the cancellation of the Special Stage.

**No parking and there is a towaway zone** along the whole final stretch of the access road to the Public zone, that is from the parking area staged by the organization up to the beginning of the Special Stage.

Reaching the Public Area H, you must pay attention to the narrow Provincial Road SP 79 because of there are the Service vehicles of the event and because of the transit of the racing cars, which drive in the opposite direction.

Don't try to reach the start of the Special Stage because, considering the scarce wideness, the interested roads will be reserved only for the transit of the racing cars and closed to traffic from 06h00 to 20h30.

Please avoid parking vehicles which could hinder the transit, because you could cause the cancellation of the Special Stage.
