

**Second day (signposted in blue) – SS 7 – 10 Punta Pianedda**

First driver: 09h39 – 14h56

Km: 18,53

Road closing time: from 06h39 to 18h30 on 17<sup>th</sup> May

**Zone I at 9,62 from the start**

Access road:

1. From Olbia follow the signs road to Nuoro and go on to the State Road SS 131dcn, which is a four-lane State Road,
2. after 14 km, at level with the 131th km, take the exit to Padru,
3. go along for about 10 km and having reached Padru go on the left to Buddusò,
4. after about 17 km, at the crossroads to Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go on to Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at the crossroads to Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn left on to the State Road SS389 in the direction of Alà dei Sardi,
6. pass through Alà dei Sardi and at the exit from the small village, leave the State Road SS 389 to Buddusò and turn right in the direction of the stadium,
7. go ahead for about 4,3 km on an asphalted road at the beginning, which then becomes on gravel,
8. when you reach a wide clearing, turn left on to a long straight stretch, which skirts a Forestry Corps's barrack and an artificial lake. Going to the right, this road follows the course of the Special Stage SS 2-5 Castrazza for about 3km, raced the previous day.

Notes:

Handy access road and excellent parking opportunities at the start.

Bend at a right angle to the right, which goes to a slope with a quite visibility but a few space for the public because of the thick forest.

Walking for 500 m the opposite way of the Special Stage, you reach a passage next to a little lake, not technically challenging but interesting from the photographic point of view.

If you going on to about 500 m in the way of the Special Stage, you reach some passages between the characteristic stones.

Both in these place the visibility and the capacity are quite limited because of/cause to the forestry.

**Note!**

A part of the gravel access road to the Public zone I will be used as Special Stage the previous day. For this reason the roadbed could result with damages by the transit of the racing cars.

**Zone L at 12,19 km from the start**

1. From Olbia follow the signs road to Nuoro and go on to the State Road SS 131, which is a four-lane State Road,
2. after 14 km, at level with the 131th km, take the exit to Padru,
3. go along for about 10 km and having reached Padru go on the left to Buddusò,
4. after about 17 km, at the crossroads to Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go on to Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at the crossroads to Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn left on to the State Road SS389 in the direction of Alà dei Sardi,
6. pass through Alà dei Sardi and go on to Buddusò,
7. At the entrance to Buddusò, leave the junction to Pattada to the right and pass through the village following the signs road to Bitti,
8. when you leave the village, turn left on to the State Road SS 389 in direction Bitti,
9. after about 11 km turn left on to the Provincial Road SP 50 in direction of Mamone,
10. after about 8,5 km, leave on the right the State Road to Bitti and go to left on a gravel road in the direction of the State Forestry "FD Castrazza",
11. follow with attention the signs road staged by the organization for the full 6 km.

Notes:

Hardy parking opportunities along the final part of the access road.

Large hair pin bend to right, which goes on to a long and wide stretch with many fast bends and semi-bends.

**Rally d'Italia Sardegna**

dal 15 al 18 Maggio 2008 – Guida per gli spettatori/Spectators Guide

Everywhere wide visibility and space enough for the public.

Going in the opposite way of the Stage for 800m inside the forest, you will reach a particular passage between two big natural stones made of granite.

**Note!**

A part of the gravel access road to the Public zone I, will be used as Special Stage the previous day. For this reason the roadbed could result damaged by the transit of the racing cars.

No parking for all kind of vehicles from 06h39 to 18h30 on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> May on both the sides of the State Road SS 389 from 44<sup>th</sup> km, that is from the junction with the Provincial Road Latari, which is a wide gravel road on the left, to 45,4<sup>th</sup> km at the level with the Nuraghe Loelle, in order to permit a easy in and out coming of the racing cars at the start and at the finish of the Stage.

If you decide to go and preview the start and the finish of the Stage, we suggest that you must park in orderly way, after the 45,4 km of the State Road SS 389 that is after the Nuraghe Loelle, because it will cause a possible cancellation of the race.
