



Rally d'Italia Sardegna

dal 21 al 24 Maggio 2009 – Guida per gli spettatori/Spectators Guide

Day one (signposted in red) – SS 3 – 6 Crastazza

First car: 10h43 – 16h08

Km: 27.81

Road closing time: from 7h43 May 22nd

Zone D at 2.80 km and at 27.34 km from the start

Access road:

1. From Olbia follow indications to Nuoro and take SS 131dcn, a dual carriageway,
2. after 14 km, at km 131, take the exit signposted direction Padru,
3. continue for about 10 km, reach Padru and continue towards Buddusò,
4. after about 17 km, at the Budoni-Alà dei Sardi junction, continue towards Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at the Monti-Alà dei Sardi junction, turn left towards "Stadio" (football field),
6. continue through Alà dei Sardi, after the town leave SS389 and turn right towards the stadium
7. continue for 4.3 km on a road at first tarmac then gravel,
8. coming to a wide spot continue straight on the old "lattari" road,
9. after a series of uphill hairpins, and before the end of SS 2-5, turn left and follow the signs posted by the organisers.

PLEASE NOTE: the Lattari road will be closed at 09h00 and at 14h45.

The access road is narrow and with stones, it is therefore not advised for bulky or weak vehicles, especially mobile homes or caravans.

The access road, the last 100m of which must be done on foot, leads directly to the famous jump, highly spectacular as it is taken at high speed as before it there is a straight of more than 150m and a wide bend to the left.

Continuing along the stage for 200m you will reach the second part of Zone D, a very narrow hairpin from a light uphill to a sharp downhill.

Wide Spectators Area with plenty of space for spectators and excellent visibility everywhere.

Zone E at 9,58 km from the start

Access road 1:

1. from Olbia follow indications to Nuoro and take SS 131 dcn, a dual carriageway,
2. after 79, take the exit signposted direction Bitti.
3. outside Bitti, continue towards Buddusò
4. continue on SS 389 until Km 13.8, turn right on the SP 50 indications Mamaone and drive this road for 9 km,
5. at the junction turn left and continue until the entrance of Forest Domain "FD Crastazza", and then the Special Stage.

Access road 2:

1. from Olbia follow indications to Nuoro and take SS 131 dcn, a dual carriageway,
2. after 14 km, at km 131, take the exit signposted direction Padru,
3. continue for about 10 km, reach Padru and continue towards Buddusò,
4. after about 17 km, at the Budoni-Alà dei Sardi junction, continue towards Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at the Monti-Alà dei Sardi junction, turn left onto SS389 towards Alà dei Sardi,
6. continue through Alà dei Sardi and go on to direction Buddusò,
7. at the entrance of Buddusò pass the junction to Pattada on the right and continue through Buddusò following indications to Bitti,
8. continue until Km 13.8, turn right on the SP 50 indications Mamaone and drive this road for 9 km,
9. at the junction turn left and continue until the entrance of Forest Domain "FD Crastazza", and then the Special Stage.



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Notes:

Excellent access road since it is a wide tarmac road, with many parking facilities along it, particularly in the wide straight of about 500 m between the entrance of "FD Castrazza" and Mamone.

Excellent visibility of a short straight with a light downhill on a medium wide road with a narrow hairpin which tightens at the end, passing close to the tarmac of SP 50.

Walking along the Stage for 1.6 km, you will reach a wide hairpin in light downhill with a big natural arena, which can host spectators comfortably and allows to see about 300 m of the Special Stage, the part before and after the hairpin.
