



## RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE NATURE RESERVES

If you visit the nature reserves, you must follow some simple but fundamental rules.

Protected territories are a human treasure and, like monuments or any other masterpieces, they must be kept intact as a sign of respect for the future generations.

It is therefore important that anybody wishing to watch the Rally d'Italia Sardegna 2009 inside these areas respects and helps to ensure that others respect some essential behaviour rules:

To have, at all times and under any circumstances, a careful behaviour, respectful of the surrounding ecosystem, avoiding leaving any kind of waste, do not pick flowers, fruit, branches, or take rocks or any other natural elements in the area.

- Do not light any fires, even using apparently safe structures (barbecues or such).
- Respect wildlife. Keep a correct behaviour, watching the animals without attempting to capture or disturb them.
- Do not allow children or minors to wander away from the adults. Even a small inattention may become dangerous or cause troubles.
- Always report any danger situation to the surveillance services of the nature reserves (Sardinia Forest Authority, Forest Watchmen, marshals).
- Smoking is strictly forbidden in the nature reserves.
- Please park vehicles in order to create as little damage as possible to the surrounding vegetation, and whenever possible leave vehicles on the roads or designated parking areas.
- Always drive slowly near the Forestry barracks; in many cases there are enclosures for animals close to these buildings.
