11 – Andreucci: I have the advantage of starting behind, even if I find lots of things on the road. I am also surprised to be leading, despite a front left puncture 2 km before the end of the first stage. The second loop will be more challenging for all, as the road conditions will be similar for all. I am satisfied with the car and the tyres.

3 – Meeke: It was very difficult as I could not see the road. I found the stages more slippery than expected, I tried to improve the grip and to find the good lines both on the first and the second stage, where I was more careful.

2 – Hanninen: I had some problems running first on both stages. Very difficult to drive on a very slippery surface. I don't have a good grip and I tried to check my notes for the second pass.

1 – Ogier: He confirmed the engine problem, cause of the retirement, due to a broken water hose. He does not think he will restart tomorrow.

5 – Andersson: A pity for the puncture on SS 2, I lost over 4'. In SS 3 I did well, but I don't have feeling with the car. I must say that the stages are really nice.

8 – Magalhaes: I have no brakes. I broke the front left suspension and in SS 3 it was impossible to do better.

6 – Kopecky: On SS 3 I had a front right puncture 4 km from the end and I also broke the suspension. I still have problems with a driveshaft.

9 – Witmann: All ok. The stages are very challenging, if one pushes too hard he risks going off.

10 – Neuville: I am making experience with the car. It's easy to make a mistake. I am also fine tuning my pacenotes for the next pass.

14 – Arminen: I found SS 2 very slippery. In SS 3 it was very difficult, I also overshot a junction.

15 – Cetinkaya: It was very difficult to finish SS 2 with a rear left puncture.
