## THE RALLY D'ITALIA SARDEGNA AND THE YOUNG TALENTS OF NATIONAL MOTORSPORTS

**Andrea Crugnola and Matteo Brunello, protagonists of the WRC Academy, will take part in the event's presentation press conference on April 7<sup>th</sup> in Rome. Great expectations for what concerns the works entries with 21 WRC 1600 turbo, 10 SWRC and 20 cars of the WRC Academy at the start.**

Rome, April 1<sup>st</sup> 2011 – 21-year-old Andrea Crugnola, and 20-year-old Matteo Brunello, who are starring in the WRC Academy category inside the World Rally Championship will take part in the presentation press conference of the Rally Italia Sardegna which will be held in the central office of the Automobile Club d'Italia in Rome, Via Marsala 8 at 10.30 on April 7<sup>th</sup>. The two young promising drivers, pride of the national motorsports have received support for their programme by the CSAI, the Automobile Sports Commission of the Automobile Club d'Italia.

During the press conference the President of the Automobile Club d'Italia Enrico Gelpi and the President of the Organisation Committee Angelo Sticchi Damiani will illustrate all the details of the event which will take place from May 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>.

Everything in Sardinia is already set to welcome the great international event. **Important upcoming deadlines such as the closing of entries, scheduled for April 5<sup>th</sup> for the works teams and for April 19<sup>th</sup> for privateers while for the press accreditations, already numerous from all over the world, the delay is set at April 6<sup>th</sup>.**

Concerning the entries there already are some interesting figures. For what regards the World Championship the list sees 21 WRC 1600 turbo cars, the category that rules, 10 SWRCs and 20 cars for the young drivers of the WRC Academy, a class strongly supported by the FIA to help the growth of world rallying's young drivers. These cars will be joined by a good amount of private drivers.
